This year began with our blanket distribution in January, during which we were required to double the number of blankets distributed due to an unusually harsh winter.

We are currently exploring opportunities to establish a permanent VEI facility in Amroha, which would significantly improve access to eye care in the region.



- 18 patients were treated.


- 210 participants registered.
